WEBMAIL

You may access your email through your web browser one of two ways:

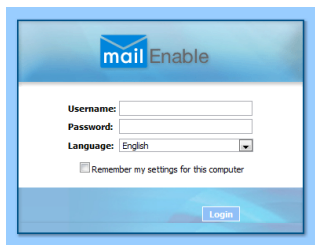
If you have a web site hosted by Franktronics, go to:

When the webmail log in screen appears, use your full email address (name@yourdomainname.com) as the username.

If you use both webmail and a mail client (such as Outlook), be sure to set your Email Client to leave messages on the server, and to delete them after 2 – 3 weeks.

Most Email accounts have a storage limit of 256MB.

Basic Email Settings For use with any Email Client:

POP3

Incoming Server:

Name: pop.YourDomainName
Port: 110
Username: your full email address
Password: your assigned password
SSL: none

Outgoing Server:

Name: smtp.YourDomainName
Port: 26 **
Requires Authentication: Yes
SSL: none

IMAP

Incoming Server:

Name: pop.YourDomainName
Port: 143
Username: your full email address
Password: your assigned password
SSL: none

Outgoing Server:

Name: smtp.YourDomainName
Port: 26
Requires Authentication: Yes
SSL: none

Notes:

- Some clients (ie iPhone) must go through their auto-discovery process before allowing you to change advanced settings, so please be patient.
- The SMTP port 26 is not the default port and must be changed
